### **Congregational Action Plan – Planning for the Future**

At the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland in 2025, a new system was introduced to replace the Local Church Review process whereby every congregation is required to complete a 5 Year Congregational Action Plan. This Plan should bring together the congregation's vision for its mission, worship, life and service, taking account of its present position, its capacity and finances.

As a first step, we are asking everyone to complete a Congregational Action Plan Survey which will be anonymous. The survey is designed to help the Kirk Session understand how the congregation views the current state of our church, in order to build our 5 year Action Plan in the most effective way. Paper copies of the survey are available over the next few Sundays, and it is also available electronically by request to [stawpc@gmail.com](mailto:stawpc@gmail.com). Once complete, please drop it into the box in the sanctuary on any Sunday, or email a completed electronic copy, up to, and including, 1st March.
